French Horn (*it is recommended students have learnt another instrument prior to French Horn*)

The cost for this tuition in 2020 will be \$28.00 per half hour. The payment must be forwarded directly to the tutors providing the service by week 2 of each term.

If you do not already have an instrument, they are able to be hired from **dB Music Solutions**. The school will oversee hire and invoicing of instruments. The cost of hiring an instrument <u>per semester (including holidays)</u>, is as follows:

Trumpet \$65	Clarinet \$65
Flute \$65	Piano Keyboard \$50

Acoustic Guitar \$45	Electric Guitar and Amp \$70
